ePortfolio @ SHS is an exploratory project between Somerville High School and the OneVille Project. Our purpose is to build capacity and leadership at SHS in order to make ePortfolios a reality at the whole high school.

Twelve students and six teachers of SHS met weekly with four members of OneVille to create their ePortfolios, which are electronic Portfolios demonstrating not only their academic strengths, but also their soft skills (21st century skills) and outside school activities. An on-line space where the students can showcase their holistic abilities to their fellow students, teachers and prospective colleges.
